LOCAL RULES AND RECOMMENDATIONS

- The "Desert Rule" applies for all native areas, in which you can drop a ball from last turf crossing point, within 2-club-length range, with one stroke penalty. If you decide to play from where the ball is lying, you can ground the club and move lose impediments.
- Formal bunkers will be easily identified by the availability of rakes. All bunkers and sand areas without rakes at hand are considered "waste area", so you can ground the club and remove lose impediments, according to the official rules of the USGA.
- The comfort stations will slow pace of play, please consider players from behind.
- RESTROOMS LOCATED AT CLUBHOUSE, HOLE 5, HOLE 8/9, HOLE 16.
- Rattle snakes, other dangerous animals and spiky plants, are part of the environment at Quivira Golf Club, that is why searching for balls and walking through the native areas, is under player's responsibility.
